



SHEPHERD PATHWAYS POST-ACUTE BRAIN INJURY SERVICES

Shepherd Center has a national reputation for helping people with brain injuries become as independent as possible and return to a meaningful life. Shepherd Center provides a full continuum of care that is focused on community re-entry, which for many people means returning to home, work or a supported, community-living environment. Our expert treatment teams are managed by physiatrists and a multidisciplinary team of rehabilitation specialists, and coordinated by case managers, who develop discharge plans focused on community reintegration.

LOCATION AND SETTING

Shepherd Pathways is located in Decatur, Georgia, just north of Atlanta. The facility includes treatment rooms, two large therapy gyms, a computer lab, state-of-the-art technology, outdoor sports equipment, and a putting green for recreational and leisure activities.

The residential program has 11 designated beds that are supported by licensed professional nurses and life skills trainers, who support individual treatment goals in collaboration with the treatment team.
